## Office of Defense Coordination hits the web

The recently formed Office of Defense Coordination (ODC) has a [new website](#) that highlights its support to the Department of Defense (DoD) as the unified point-of-contact and Laboratory-wide clearinghouse for information regarding DoD as a partner and sponsor.

Users can learn about ODC's key DoD partners and thrust areas, including areas of interest for potential applications of Laboratory capabilities and technologies to meet DoD mission needs. The website also features biographies of ODC's staff, advisers, military fellows and administrative staff. A News section highlights recent events, seminars and conferences sponsored by ODC or other organizations at the Lab with a DoD focus. A Bookshelf includes links to recent papers and videos. A special LLNL-only resource link includes more than 200 papers, reports and articles related to strategic deterrence and is designed to help researchers working on both technical and policy aspects of deterrence and national security. Lastly, a Related Links section provides easy access to DoD, Military Department, Combatant Command and Defense Agency websites.

"The ODC website provides LLNL with important information on our partnership with the Department of Defense," said Randy Simpson, interim ODC director. "We are seeing increasing interest across the Laboratory to connect to the national security missions of the DoD and this website can be a resource for researchers already well-connected to the DoD and for those wanting to become involved in this work,"
